South Wales Anti-social Behaviour Community Trigger



What is the Community Trigger?

The South Wales Community Trigger allows victims of persistent anti-social behaviour, who have previously reported incidents to one or more agencies, to request a review of their case where they feel the actions taken have not been adequate.

This is a joint initiative between local authorities, South Wales Police, South Wales Police and Crime Commissioner, local health boards and registered social landlords.

What will the Community Trigger do?

- Bring relevant agencies together
- Share information
- Review the actions that have been taken
- Try to reach a solution
- Prevent similar incidents from happening again

Who can use the Community Trigger?

- Victims of anti-social behaviour
- Someone representing a victim such as a carer, councillor or family member. (Consent must be gained from the victim prior to the application).
- Communities or Businesses

What to do next?

You can activate the trigger by completing the attached form or online and submitting it to the relevant local authority. You can ask a friend, relative, or support worker to submit this for you.
